2. Manage player evaluations in liaison with Club Coach & Grading Committee within accordance with approved protocols for player evaluation at the Club .
3. Be reasonable in your demands as a Coach on the players time, energy and enthusiasm.
4. ADHERE to TTG Coaches Code of Conduct.
5. Provide assistance within the Club, as needed, and attend Relevant Club Coach Netball Clinics.
6. Be familiar with and committed to all Tea Tree Gully Club policies including Member Protection Policy, Coach's Code of Conduct and Dispute Resolution Policy. Maintain all information obtained as part of this role and all dealings with the Tea Tree Gully Netball Club as confidential.
7. Hold all information obtained as part of this role and all dealings with Tea Tree Gully Netball Club as Confidential.

8. Attend and promote Tea Tree Gully fundraising events, presentations and seek a "Team Sponsorship" for your team.

Position Summary: The Coach is a member of Tea Tree Gully Netball Club who has responsibility for the coordination of coaching and player evaluations within assigned age groups at Primary to Senior levels within the Club. In particular, there is responsibility to ensure club requirements and personnel development strategies for each age group are implemented in accordance with approved plans and strategies. Mentoring becomes important in this regard to ensure firstly, coaches undertake their role in accordance with approved guidelines and secondly player evaluations are conducted as required. In particular, is assistance to individual coaches or players who may require guidance to achieve personal goals for development.
